

ORDINANCE No. 98/2025
Rector of the University of Wrocław
of 22 April 2025

on the organisation of the academic year 2025/2026
at the University of Wrocław

Pursuant to Article 23, sections 1 and 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended) and § 11 of the Rules and Regulations for Studies at the University of Wrocław – Resolution No. 68/2024 of the Senate of the University of Wrocław of 24 April 2024 (as amended) it is ordered as follows:

§ 1. The organisation of the academic year 2025/2026 is determined as follows:

WINTER SEMESTER
01.10.2025–20.02.2026

Solemn Inauguration	– 01.10.2025
Teaching period	– 02.10.2025–04.02.2026*
Rector's days (days free of classes)	– 10.11.2025 – 14.11.2025 (University Day)
Winter break (Christmas)	– 22.12.2025–06.01.2026
Examination session	– 05.02.2026–13.02.2026
Retake examination session	– 14.02.2026–20.02.2026
*on Wednesday 26.11.2025,	– the Monday schedule of classes is to be held
*on Thursday 08.01.2026,	– the Tuesday schedule of classes is to be held

SUMMER SEMESTER
21.02.2026–30.09.2026

Teaching period	– 21.02.2026–16.06.2026*
Rector's days (days free of classes)	– 05.06.2026 – "Juwenalia", Students' Festival (date to be set by separate Rector's ordinance)
Spring break (Easter)	– 03.04.2026–07.04.2026
Examination session	– 17.06.2026–30.06.2026
Retake examination session	– 01.09.2026–09.09.2026
Semester holidays:	– 01.07.2026–31.08.2026 – 10.09.2026–30.09.2026
*on Tuesday 17.03.2026,	– the Friday schedule of classes is to be held
*on Monday 20.04.2026,	– the Friday schedule of classes is to be held
*on Wednesday 20.05.2026,	– classes will be held for the Juwenalia

§ 2. For students in the final year of a study programme, the dean, in consultation with the appropriate student self-government body, may introduce changes in the organisation of the academic year established by the Rector, rescheduling examination

sessions.

§ 3. Part-time study sessions are held according to schedules established and announced by the dean no later than 7 days before the start of classes. The organisation of sessions of part-time studies should not violate the organisation of the academic year referred to in § 1.

§ 4. Supervision of the implementation of this Ordinance shall be entrusted to the Vice-Rector for teaching and the Vice-Rector for student affairs.

§ 5. The Ordinance shall come into effect as of the date of signature.
